

WSSD Travel Policy

Travel increases your chance of getting and spreading COVID-19. CDC recommends that you do not travel at this time. Delay travel and stay home to protect yourself and others from COVID-19. WSSD can not require families to refrain from travel but we are asking that travel be limited.

If families choose to travel, WSSD requirements are as follows:

Families that choose to travel by air must return to their primary residence AND stay home in self-quarantine for a full 14 days after travel. This applies to any member of the household who travels. If a parent travels, the student would need to begin quarantine upon the parent's return. Families also have the option to test for COVID after being home for 5 days (COVID incubation period is 3-5 days) and return to school once they receive a negative result.

For any other form of travel or change in cohort group such as participation in a social gathering or visits from extended family, we also ask that you self-quarantine. The current travel guidelines for the State of California recommend no travel at this time beyond 120 miles (see the link below).

If families experience COVID symptoms at any point during the quarantine period, we ask that you test for COVID prior to returning to campus.

If families choose to travel and do not return with enough time to allow for the quarantine window (specified above) to be completed before the return to school, the school is not required to provide instruction for your student during the missed school days.

We ask that you visit the CDC and California.gov travel guidelines <https://covid19.ca.gov/travel/> to familiarize yourself with the guidance on travel.
